APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

1. A high school senior or graduate of a public or non-public high school in Bradford, Tioga, Sullivan or Lycoming Counties in PA.
2. Accepted to an accredited college, university or professional school in a program leading to a degree in education, medicine, public service or a trade.
3. A cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES:

The scholarship will be awarded for the first year of higher education only and will be in an amount determined by the selection committee. Funds may be used to help pay for tuition, books and room and board. Payments from the Trust will be made directly to the university, college or professional school the recipient attends.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Final scholarships will be determined by a selection committee as set forth in the Peter C. Van Vlack Scholarship Trust Agreement. Consideration will be given to financial need.

APPLICATIONS:

Applications are due to the student's high school guidance office by **April 1, 2022**, or to a C&N office by **April 4, 2022**.

The Peter C. Van Vlack scholarship is now available. The graduates of the Class of 2022 class are encouraged to apply if their major fits the criteria described in more detail below.
