



St. John Neumann Regional Academy Elementary Campus Overview

- This campus houses Grade Pre-K through Grade 5.
- Average Student/Teacher Ratio, Grades K-5: 20:1
- Grades Pre-K, K, 1, 2 and 3 are self-contained (one teacher teaches every subject).
- Classes rotate rooms and teachers in grades 4 and 5.
- The core courses of Math, Science, Social Studies, English/Language Arts and Reading are supplemented by teachings in Religion, Computer Science, Art, Music and Physical Education.
- Children are taught the importance of giving back to one's church, community and the world.
- Gifted/Remedial teachers on staff.
- SJNRA Director of Religious Formation and Chaplain oversee the religious education program.
- Students attend Mass weekly and celebrate all church holidays. Opportunities for confession and adoration are offered twice a year.
- Many extra-curricular activities available for students: Interscholastic Reading Competition, Odyssey of the Mind, Student Council, Art Contests and Elementary Choir.
- Hot lunch & milk available for purchase.
- Uniform required for all students K-5th grade – available for purchase at Flynn & O'Hara. Order on-line at www.flynnohara.com. Gym uniform available for purchase through the school.
- Tuition assistance is awarded annually to qualifying families. All interested families must complete appropriate forms.
- School day begins at 7:55 am and ends at 2:40 pm. Aftercare is available until 5:30 pm for a separate fee.
