

# **SJNRA Elementary**

## **Daily Monitoring of Health**

1. Temperature checks will be conducted on anyone entering the building
2. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed into the building
3. Students will have their temperature taken after getting out of their vehicle and before the parent leaves.
4. Physical distancing will be in place in hallways, classrooms, and common areas

## **Entering the Building**

1. Masks must be worn upon entering the building.
2. All who enter the building will sanitize their hands.
3. All doors will be propped open from 7:30 a.m. until homeroom begins.
4. Hallway and stairwell doors will be propped open all day.
5. Hand sanitizing stations will be installed throughout the building.
6. Plexiglass will be installed at the office windows.
7. Visitors and volunteers will be strictly limited.

## **Classroom Set-up**

1. Students will go directly to homeroom upon entering the building
2. Desks will be spaced 6 feet apart and all facing the same direction
3. Students will be provided tri-fold shields for their desks
4. Specials will take place in the classroom or outdoors
5. Students will be limited to one in the restroom at a time
6. Restrooms and common areas will be sanitized throughout the day

## **Traveling Within the Building**

1. Masks must be worn when moving throughout the building
2. Hallways and stairwells will be designated as one way
3. Water fountains will not be used. Students will be permitted to have water bottles

## **Lunch**

1. Students will sanitize upon entering the cafeteria
2. Students will be distanced in the cafeteria
3. Buyers will be served their lunch trays.
4. Students will sanitize upon exiting the cafeteria
5. Cafeteria will be sanitized between lunch periods
6. Recess will be contained to individual cohorts and each grade will have designated equipment. Equipment will be sanitized after use.

### **Physical Education**

1. Phys Ed will be outside as much as possible.
2. Each grade will have designated equipment for their use
3. Equipment will be sanitized after being used
4. Students will sanitize before and after physical education

# **SJNRA High School**

## **Daily Monitoring of Health**

1. Temperature checks will be conducted on anyone entering the building
2. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be permitted in the building
3. Physical distancing will be in place in hallways, classrooms, and common areas

## **Entering the Building**

1. Masks must be worn upon entering the building.
2. All who enter the building will sanitize their hands.
3. All doors will be propped open from 7:30 a.m. until homeroom begins.
4. Hallway and stairwell doors will be propped open all day.
5. Hand sanitizing stations will be installed throughout the building.
6. Plexiglass will be installed at the office windows.
7. Visitors and volunteers will be strictly limited.

## **Classroom Set-up**

1. All desks will be facing in the same direction.
2. Desks will be six feet apart.
3. Students will carry tri-fold shields from class to class. Tri-fold shields will be returned to homeroom at the end of the school day to be properly sanitized.
4. A warning bell will sound about 2 minutes before class ends whereupon teachers will stop teaching and instruct the students to wipe down their desks and get ready to leave.
5. Students will use hand sanitizer upon entering the classrooms and anytime devices or school materials are shared.
6. Sharing of any devices or school materials will be cleaned between each use.
7. Outdoor classrooms will also be utilized as much as possible in the courtyard, lawn and parking lot.

## **Traveling Within the Building**

1. Visitors and volunteers will be strictly limited.
2. Plexiglass will be installed at office windows.
3. All students, faculty and staff must wear masks/face coverings when traveling throughout the building.
4. Hand sanitizing stations will be installed throughout the building.
5. Hallway and stairwell will be designated as one way
6. Hallway and stairwell doors will be propped open throughout the day
7. Students will be limited to the number of individuals allowed in the restrooms at a time. Faculty will be instructed to only send one at a time to the restrooms.
8. Students must sanitize before entering every classroom.

9. Water fountains will be turned off. Students will be allowed to carry a clear water bottle.
10. Students will be allowed to use their lockers. The lockers will be spaced and locker visits will be controlled by teachers. Students will be allowed to carry backpacks.
11. Increased cleaning of bathrooms, railings and doorknobs will be completed during the school day

### **Lunch**

1. Students will sanitize upon entering the cafeteria
2. Students will be distanced in the cafeteria
3. Buyers will be sent through the line by lunch monitors
4. Masks must be worn when moving throughout the cafeteria
5. Trays and utensils will be prepared and ready
6. Students will be offered the option of outdoor eating when weather permits
7. Students will sanitize upon exiting the cafeteria
8. Cafeteria will be sanitized between lunch periods

### **Physical Education and Athletics**

1. Phys Ed will be outside as much as possible
2. Students will sanitize hands upon entering and exiting the gymnasium
3. Clear water bottles are permitted
4. Each class will have designated equipment.
5. Equipment will be sanitized after each use
6. Students will sanitize before and after physical education
7. All athletics and extra-curricular teams will follow the recommendations of PIAA

### **Dismissal**

1. Students will be dismissed by class in staggering times
2. Students will be encouraged to wait outside for rides
3. Students will be distanced in commons if waiting for rides
