- Registration forms must be returned to the school of the oldest student.
- To register, your account must be in good standing. Please refer to the **Tuition Policy** on our website at www.dioceseofscranton.org/catholicschools.
- In an effort to make our schools affordable, additional resources are being dedicated to financial assistance. We also have opportunities in each school to reduce tuition through SCRIP, referral of new families, events, etc. Please see the enclosed information on Tuition Reduction Opportunities.
