Dear St. John Neumann Regional Academy Parents and Guardians:

Our fundraising efforts over the past several years have been extremely successful, and we thank all of you for your continued dedicated support. For the 2020-21 school year, the fundraising and volunteer hour commitment remains unchanged. The requirement for all families with children in grades PreK-12 is \$500 in raffle tickets, and we request that you complete 10 volunteer hours.

- **10 volunteer hours:** A donation of a Mega basket for our Annual Basket Bonanza (held in the fall), with a value of at least \$125, will fulfill all 10 volunteer hours. A donation of a regular basket(s) will earn you 2.5 hours each. Volunteer help is always needed in our cafeterias at lunchtime, and help will be needed with our various fundraisers throughout the year. Hours can also be earned by participating in our Gift Card/Tuition Voucher program (1 hour for every \$500 spent), donating your time to work at the concession stand at our sporting events, or serving as a member of any of our parent committees.
- **Fall Raffle: each family is required to sell or buy \$250 in tickets.** Tickets will be sent to each family in early September.
- **Spring Raffle: each family is required to sell or buy \$250 in tickets.** Tickets will be sent to each family in the spring.

We have been diligent with our fundraising efforts, and have tried to not overtax our families with unnecessary fundraisers. We work hard throughout the year to implement fundraisers that are profitable and successful. The \$500 raffle ticket commitment from each family is an essential component of the fundraising budget, and we need every family's help to meet our goal. If you would prefer to add your \$500 ticket expense on to your tuition and spread the payment out over the school year, please contact our High School office at 570-323-9953.
